Frequently Asked Questions Master Degree Scholarship Program in China 2018

Q1. What does the Scholarship pay for?

The 2 year Masters Scholarship course and Accommodation for two years.

Q2. What expenses will I have?

You will incur a fee of \$2500 USD for this Application fees. You are responsible for all daily living costs and transport costs etc.

Q3. When does the scholarship start?

The Scholarship intake at <u>Nanjing University of Information Science & Technology</u> (NUIST) is in September 2018

Q4. What will happen to my existing Australian study Visa and can I return to Australia when I complete my Masters degree in China?

Your Australian student Visa might be cancelled and you can re apply for a Student Visa when and if you want to return

Q5. What will happen if I leave Australia before I finish my studies with Qii?

Your studies at Qii can be suspended or you can choose to withdraw from the course you are studying.

Q6. If my Australian Student Visa expires before September 2018 when the scholarship in China begins, what should I do?

Please ask Reception to arrange a meeting so we can discuss your options regarding this.

Q7. What Chinese Visa do I need for this Scholarship?

You will be required to hold a Chinese X1 Visa, which will be arranged for you.

Q8. Does the Chinese Student Visa allow me to work in China while I am studying?

There are no provisions to allow you to work in China under the X1 Visa

Q9. After I submit my Expression of Interest for this scholarship, when will the interviews take place?

Interviews for the scholarship places will take place on:

- 2nd Interview 23rd November 2017
