STEP 2: DECLARATION OF FINANCIAL CAPACITY

Finally, your agent must explain to you that the relevant funds must be in your bank account *at least 3 months prior* to the commencement of your studies.

As suggested by the Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP), the table below outlines in Australia dollars (AUD) the minimum annual requirement you will need in order to be eligible to obtain a student visa. **NOTE: The below amounts do not necessarily represent the cost of living in Australia.**
